Dear Robert,

We have received an e-mail response from Natural England which states that due to staff resourcing issues, they are not in a position to provide comments in line with the Gargrave NP examination timetable.

As referred to previously in an e-mail to you, we do have recent comments from Natural England on this matter (set out below). They concur with the conclusion of no adverse effects on the integrity of the Ingleborough Complex Special Area of Conservation (SAC), North Pennine Moors SAC and North Pennine Moors Special Protection Area, based on the combination of the local plans of Craven and Harrogate. It can be reasonably inferred that the proposed development in Gargrave's NP is highly unlikely to result in adverse effects, based on the research and information presented in the neighbourhood plan.

**Response from Natural England (28/11/2018):**

*"Air Quality Natural England welcomes the additional figures and analysis provided in the HGV Flows Along the A59, 65 and A6068 spreadsheet, Harrogate Traffic Flow Data Spreadsheet and HGV Traffic Flows Along The A59: Analysis of the Traffic Modelling Tables document which illustrate the conclusions reached in the Habitats Regulations Assessment. Based on the figures provided we concur with the conclusion of no adverse effects on the integrity of the Ingleborough Complex Special Area of Conservation (SAC), North Pennine Moors SAC and North Pennine Moors Special Protection Area. However as noted in our previous advice we advise that you ensure that the traffic modelling methodology is in line with the industry standard."*
